Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 6 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.7 to 13.

Heard.

In the present case, FIR No.62 dated 06.05.2014 was registered under Sections 457, 307, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 182, 195, 211, 120-B IPC added later on) and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Baghapurana at the instance of Baldev Kaur.

However, during the course of investigation, it transpired that false FIR has been registered and consequently, petitioners were arrayed as accused in the said FIR. Petitioners had approached this Court seeking anticipatory bail and the said petitions have been allowed.

In these circumstances, at this stage, no ground for further interference by this Court is called for.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
