Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C, is for quashing of FIR No.402, dated 14.06.2014, registered under Sections 384, 506 of the IPC and Sections 25, 30, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Jhajjar, on the basis of a compromise, arrived at between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in a connected matter bearing CRM-M No.26710 of 2014, filed by the co-accused of the petitioner, wherein statements of the parties have been recorded and report

of the trial Court has come attesting to the fact that both the parties have amicably settled the matter, this Court has quashed the instant FIR qua the co-accused of the petitioner, vide order of even date, and prays that this petition may also be disposed of in the same terms.

Counsel for the State of Haryana, as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not denied the factual assertions.

Consequently, the present petition is allowed in the same terms as in CRM-M No.26710 of 2014.
