This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.27 dated 27.02.2014 under Section 365 IPC and Sections 302/201 IPC (added later on) at Police Station P.S. Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Maghar Singh submits that trial is nearing its culmination. Case is fixed before the trial court on 08.06.2015 when remaining prosecution witnesses are likely to be examined.

In view of the above, no case for enlarging the petitioners on bail is made out. However, a fresh right will accrue to the petitioners to seek bail in case trial does not conclude within a period of four months.

Dismissed.
