Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No. 128 dated 6.9.2011 registered under Sections 323, 324 read with Section 34 of IPC and Section 307 of IPC (added later on) at Police Station Sadar, Taran Taran, District Taran Taran.

A perusal of file shows that main injury was on the head of Guruiqbal Singh with sword attributed to petitioner Fateh Singh. On instructions from SI Gulzar Singh, learned State counsel states that in this case challan has been presented and charges are yet to be framed. No eye-witness and injured has been examined. Thus, keeping in view the seriousness of the case, there is no ground for granting regular bail.

Dismissed at this stage.
