Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 72, dated 06.08.2013, registered at Police Station, Bhindi Saidan, District-Amritsar Rural, in which Section 326 IPC has been added later on.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Semuel, Police Station, Bhindi Saidan, very fairly conceded that in compliance of the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 23.02.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 23.02.2015, are made absolute.

However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
