As per allegations of the prosecution, the petitioner along with six other persons have robbed of the complainant for a sum of ₹20,000/- and 313 mustard bags.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that complainant as well as Dashrath-cleaner of the truck have been examined in the trial court and both of them have not supported the case of prosecution. He has further submitted that there is no recovery from the petitioner and he has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused Chetan, Dara Singh and Prem.

The said factual position has not been disputed by the learned State counsel. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 15.06.2014.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition stands allowed. Petitioner Shri Bhagwan @ Neetu is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial court.
