Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, "Cr.P.C.") is for grant of regular bail to petitioner Gurpreet Singh @ Sona in case First Information Report No.169 dated 12.09.2014 under Sections 15/27-A/61/85 of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

2. Precisely, the case of the prosecution was that on 12.09.2014 the petitioner was found transporting two bags containing 27 kgs. Chura Post each i.e. commercial quantity.

3. The custody certificate by way of affidavit of J.S. Sethi, Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa, has been placed on record by learned Assistant Advocate General for the State of Haryana. As per the said certificate, the petitioner has undergone 7 months and 8 days in custody.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced copy of order dated 28.01.2015 of this Court vide which co-accused of the petitioner namely Manjit Singh, was enlarged on regular bail. The trial is still likely to take more time and in view of facts and circumstances noticed above and without going into merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
