The allegations against the petitioners are that they were selling lottery tickets to the public on a loud speaker, promising them to give bicycle, scooter, Alto Car, T.V., Cooler, R.O. etc. on the date of draw. They were collecting ₹50/- for each ticket.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the matter, I am of the view that the police needs to be given a free hand to investigate the matter, so that no cheating is to be done with the public.

Therefore, there is no ground for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Dismissed.
