The petitioner along with another person Jeewan Singh and two other unidentified persons attacked the complainant Jagjit Singh in Gudwara Sahib with weapons.

Counsel for the complainant informs that the matter has been compromised.

State counsel informs that 6 out of 11 witnesses have been examined.

It is admitted fact that in the present case the matter appears to have been compromised with the petitioner only whereas the proceedings against the co-accused are still pending.

In view of above circumstance I do not deem it appropriate to

partially quash the FIR on compromise.

This petition is dismissed. However, it is observed that on the basis of statement of complainant made in the Court qua the role of petitioner, it will be open to the trial Court to acquit the petitioner on merits.

It is observed that the right of the petitioner to file fresh petition by joining the other co-accused will not be barred.
