This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 11.9.2014.

It is the prosecution case that the petitioner, who was armed with a kirpan at the time of the occurrence, had not caused any injury to the deceased. The injury which was said to have been caused by him to one of the prosecution witnesses, was found to be simple in nature. The petitioner is in custody since 4.9.2013. The trial of the case has not made any significant progress as out of more than forty witnesses cited by the prosecution, only three have been examined so far. Surjit Singh @ Kala, co-accused of the petitioner has been granted the concession of bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 30.1.2015.

Resultantly, the petition is accepted. Bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
