Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that since complaint of the petitioner has been dismissed for non-prosecution by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari, vide order dated 31.1.2015 passed in compliance of the impugned order dated 14.10.2014 (Annexure P-3), instant petition does not survive any further and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also fairly states that let the present petition be disposed of, in view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.1, however, liberty may be granted to the petitioner to pursue his other remedies, in accordance with law.

In view of the above-said statements made by the learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, with liberty as prayed for and also with further liberty to the petitioner to get the present petition revived, if necessity arises.

Disposed of, accordingly.
