This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail by the petitioner.

As per the prosecution allegations, the petitioner along with his co-accused caused injuries to complainant Piara Singh and injured Sukhjit Singh with a sword. It is alleged that he has given the sword blow on the index finger of left hand of Sukhjit Singh and another blow from the reverse side of sword on his head. This fact is not disputed that injury on the head of Sukhjit Singh was simple in nature and the injuries suffered by him on the index finger of the left hand has been declared grievous. He has also caused injury to complainant Piara Singh that is also simple in nature. Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed that

his co-accused Baljinder Singh alias Natti, who was also a proclaimed offender has already been admitted to regular bail by the learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, vide order dated 6.6.2014. The certified copy of that order has been placed on record. The present petitioner was also declared as proclaimed offender but now he is in custody since 19.12.2014. In this way he is in custody for the last more than three and half months. The case is triable by the Magistrate First Class. The trial of the case will take time as no witness has been recorded so far. Thus, the further detention of the petitioner will not serve any purpose.

So, the present petition is hereby allowed. Petitioner Gurinderpal Singh alias Gaggu is ordered to release on bail on furnishing personal bond with two sureties, one surety should be the local, to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
