This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.197 dated 26.11.2014 registered under Sections 419, 420, 120-B IPC at P.S. City Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrender before the trial Court on or before 25.02.2015 and move an application for

regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case on or before 28.02.2015 on merits. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
