Petitioner-Krishan has applied for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 873, dated 10.10.2014, under Sections 323, 354-B, 392, 506, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Line, Gurgaon.

As per allegation of the prosecution, petitioner alongwith two ladies gave beatings to complainant and her husband. It is further alleged that gold earrings, gold finger ring, gold necklace and mobile phone have been snatched.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that statement of Rakesh Kumar was recorded, who has not stated about snatching the articles, but has stated that chain fell down and mobile was not found. He has further submitted that no recovery was effected from the petitioner except motor-cycle. Mobile is stated to be recovered from the

co-accused, who is on bail granted by the trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 14.12.2014.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Mahesh Kumar, has not disputed the above said factual position.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition stands accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
