On 02.03.2015, this Court passed the following order:-

“As per office report, notices to respondents No.4 to 8 could not be issued for want of process fee.

In the meanwhile, learned counsel for petitioner may take necessary steps to serve the unserved respondents No.4 to 8.”

2. Now, as per office report notices could not be issued to respondents No.4 to 8 due to non-filing of process fee.

3. In view of aforesaid, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner that as

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soon as the petitioner receives the requisite instructions, he may file fresh petition with better particulars, within one month from today.
