MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for his release on bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case registered vide FIR No.29 dated 25.2.2014 under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Mehta, Amritsar City.

The allegations against the petitioner are based on the alleged suicide note left behind by the deceased where he implicated the petitioner and his father for having given beatings to him to force him to reside at Amritsar with his wife Balwinder Kaur with whom he was having prolonged dispute for over two decades. The FIR has been registered at the behest of the brother of the deceased.

It was contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is not even remotely connected with the dispute between the deceased and his wife and that the father of the petitioner has already been granted pre-arrest bail on similar allegations.

This Court on 3.3.2015 had granted the interim protection to the petitioner subject to the compliance of the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., pursuant to which he has since joined the investigation as has been stated by the learned counsel appearing for the State on instructions from HC Avtar Singh.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 3.3.2015 are hereby absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition allowed.
