Petitioner has filed this petition under 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.118 dated 18.03.2014, under Sections 279, 379, 188, 120-B, 353, 186, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Mewat.

Prosecution story in brief is that on 16.03.2014 at about 7:00 AM, during inspection, dumpers bearing No. HR-55-M-8269 and HR-55-4283 were found have been loaded with stones. When the checking team signaled the said vehicles to stop, the drivers of the vehicles sped away towards Sohna side from village Pipaka. The dumpers were stopped at Sohna on Gurgaon road. Petitioner who was the owner of the dumpers, alongwith 10-15 persons, started abusing the checking team and fled away from the spot. Vehicle bearing

No. HR-55-M-8269 had already been booked on two occasions by the checking team of Mining Department qua illegal theft.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR in question was registered after a delay of two days. Petitioner had been falsely involved in this case due to personal enmity with the police officials.

In the present case, allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. Admittedly, petitioner is the owner of vehicle bearing No. HR-55-M-8269 and said vehicle was earlier also apprehended on two occasions qua theft by the checking team of Mining Department. As per the prosecution story, petitioner alongwith others had abused the checking team. Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation.

Dismissed.
