Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to register an FIR against the private respondents . He is stated to have written a complaint to the President of SGPC, Amritsar, copy of which has also been forwarded to the various higher police authorities including respondent No.2 in this regard but no action has been taken thereon as yet.

Resultantly the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take whatever action he deems necessary on the complaint (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
