JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the FIR No. 44, dated 19.03.2007, for offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code (**Annexure P-1**), registered at Police Station Division No. 2, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings therefrom on the basis of alleged compromise (**Annexure P-2**).

The Manager of the Canara Bank lodged an FIR with the allegations that the petitioner had obtained person loan of Rs. 1 lac under the scheme Can Budget Scheme, available to the employees of banks/certain departments etc., by forging documents to falsely show that he was employee of the railway department.

A perusal of **Annexure P-2** reveals that only, the account with the bank has been settled and as such, there is no compromise regarding the alleged forgery.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Balwinder Singh, states that out of fifteen prosecution witnesses, only six witnesses have been examined.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner, prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
