NAVITA SINGH, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 71 dated 01.07.2010, under Sections 324, 326, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Siwan, District Kaithal, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Report from SDJM, Guhla has been received regarding the compromise.

Complainant-Piara Singh made a statement that he has compromised the matter with the present petitioner.

It is submitted that there were cross-cases, in which all the accused were acquitted and only the petitioner was not acquitted, as at that time he had been declared proclaimed offender. Separate charge-sheet against him has not yet been filed. On the other side, one of the accused Baldev Singh who was declared proclaimed offender, and the proceedings for declaring him proclaimed offender were quashed and the

FIR was also quashed. Petitioner is the only person, against whom the case is still pending.

In view of facts and circumstances given above and the fact that all persons of other side have been acquitted and FIR stands quashed qua the relevant persons, it is felt that holding the accused for trial in such situation would not be in the interest of justice and also he has already been released on bail

In view of the above, the petition is accepted. The above-said FIR and the proceedings connected therewith qua petitioner-Jaswinder Singh are hereby quashed.

Disposed of.
