Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 194, dated 18.11.2014, under Sections 498-A, 406, 307, 120-B, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

While issuing notice of motion on 08.01.2015, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, directed that in the even of arrest, petitioners would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer in

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the matter has been compromised between the parties.
