Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C, is for the issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos.4 & 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age, petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of his matriculation certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 11.3.1993. Petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of her adhar card (Annexure P-2) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1996. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertent to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (respondent No.2) to take an appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Copy of this order be given dasti to counsel for the petitioners on payment of usual charges.
