Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.02 dated 19.01.2015, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda, under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 13(1) (d) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 19.02.2015, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released

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on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from DSP Bhupender Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 19.02.2015 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
