Petitioner Karnail Singh has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.101 dated 07.11.2014, registered at Police Station Bakhshiwala, District Patiala, under Sections 458, 294, 109, 323,325, 506, 148, 149 and 459 IPC (Section 459 IPC) added lateron.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for complainant have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned State counsel and learned counsel for complainant and have gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, only accused Gola Singh entered the house of complainant and remaining accused were standing outside. No specific injury has been attributed to petitioner Karnail Singh. Two specific injuries including grievous injury have been attributed to co-accused Gola Singh. The petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the merits of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 08.01.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
