The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 198 dated 19.9.2014 registered under Section 21/22/29/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Charan Singh submits that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Paramajit Singh @ Kala and Jagtar Singh have approached this Court for grant of regular bail by way of filing Crl. Misc. Nos. M-40121 and 43665 of 2014, respectively and when the Court was not inclined to grant bail, aforesaid petitions were dismissed as withdrawn on 23.1.2015. Learned State counsel further contends that the investigation is still in progress and same has not been concluded so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition at this stage.
