This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 06 dated 11.01.2012, under Sections 419, 420, 406 IPC and 24 of Emigration Act, 1983 registered at Police Station Kotkapura Sadar, District Faridkot, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

In terms of the order passed by this Court on 19.02.2015, statement of the parties stands recorded by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridkot.

It is submitted by counsel for respondent No.2 that the marriage between Navjot Kaur and Gaganpreet Singh-son of respondent No.2 was declared a nullity and appeal against that stood withdrawn.

The allegations against the petitioners were that they had misrepresented the complainant that Navjot Kaur had come from England

and would take the entire family abroad, after getting married with the son of the complainant.

It has been stated by counsel for the parties that the parties have compromised the matter. The dispute between the parties was of personal nature. In view of this, there should not be any impediment in allowing the parties to compromise the matter. Support to this view can be had from the authority **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab, 2008 (2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, wherein Hon'ble the Supreme Court has ruled that in such type of cases where the dispute is of personal nature, Court should ordinarily accept the compromise.

In view of the above, the petition is accepted. The above-said FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.

Disposed of.
