Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.24 dated 24.01.2015 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station NIT Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Every sincere effort has been made by the Court to bring the parties to an amicable settlement. The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre but the parties failed to arrive at an amicable settlement.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties and going through the record of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner has been found entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail, as his custodial interrogation will not be required.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further on merits of the case at this stage, instant petition is allowed. Order dated 19.02.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
