This petition has been moved by Onkar Singh under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.977 dated 21.10.2014 registered under Sections 392 and 397 IPC (307 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station City Karnal.

It is submitted by the State Counsel that there are three other cases of similar nature against the petitioner. Also, the petitioner and other assailants were the students of the complainant who is now Principal of the school concerned and they entered the house of their teacher and assaulted her and her husband criminally with sharp aged weapons with an attempt to commit robbery. However, it is submitted that though the challan was submitted under Section 307 IPC, the charge was not framed against the accused persons for that.

Counsel for the complainant has no information as to whether that order was challenged.

In view of the facts given above, it is felt that grant of bail to the petitioner will not be in the interest of justice as there is likelihood that he will indulge in criminal activity or may also pressurise the witnesses and/or tamper with the other evidence.

Dismissed.
