This petition has been filed by petitioner Sukhdev Singh under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter called Cr.P.C) for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 116 dated 12.12.2014, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereinafter called IPC), registered at Police Station Sadar, Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

As per the prosecution allegations, Gagandeep Singh the employee of the complainant Kanwarvir Singh (PW-10) Singh Singh had brought the gold and LED from Thailand, which were snatched from him when he was on way from Amritsar to Delhi. The allegations are that these

articles were snatched by Prem Singh, Harpreet Singh and Narinder Singh @ Maldi. The allegations revealed during the investigation against the present petitioner are that the sim card of mobile phone issued in the name of the petitioner was used by co-accused Prem Singh.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Sarabjit Singh stated that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and has been sufficiently interrogated. No recovery is to be effected from him and he is not required for any custodial interrogation. ASI Sarabjit Singh has also informed that now the parties have settled their dispute.

Thus, the order of interim bail dated 08.01.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petition stands disposed of.
