This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petition in case FIR No.144 dated 26.12.2014, Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar City under Section 452/326/325/323/148/149 IPC.

Counsel for the State submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner that he had caused injuries to Harjinder Singh on back side of head which has resulted into an offence under Section 325 and has also caused injuries to Pyara Singh on thigh and left leg with weapons accompanied with the other person who was armed with deadly weapons. The recovery of the weapons is yet to be effected.

Thus, taking into consideration the nature of offence, the case is at initial stage and custodial interrogation is necessary, no ground is made out to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
