SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 184 dated 29.10.2014 under Sections 15, 61 and 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sambhu, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the recovery of contraband effected from the petitioner is 50 kg 400 grams of poppy husk and he submits that the recovery is marginally excess than that of commercial quantity which is 50 kg of poppy husk.

Submitting that the petitioner is in custody for the last about 7 months

learned counsel prayed that he be enlarged on regular bail.

The prayer was opposed by learned State counsel and he prays for dismissal of the present petition.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in the near future, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is released on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
