By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.181, dated 22.12.2006, registered under Section 397 IPC, at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar.

The short affidavit along with medical report obtained from the Medical Officer, Central Jail, Amritsar, filed today in the Court is taken on record. The relevant para of medical report reads as under:-

“It is requested that convict Krishan Kumar @ Bholu is a patient of HCV+ virus. Patient was confirmed a case of HCV+ on 27.03.2013 and when he was declared HCV+ as per report of Qualitative (PCR) Test

and his HCV genotype report was received on 08.04.2013 and was found positive in the clinical sample. Dr. P.S. Brar who examined and advised him 48 Interferon Injection and first Interferon Injection was started 04.06.2013 and last injection was given on 19.11.2013. Patient is HCV+. This report is on the basis of original record. He is known diabetic for the past two and half years. At present he is on insulin therapy.

He was referred to Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar medical emergency on 26.01.2015 due to acute breathlessness and suspected Hypoglycemia. He was discharged from Medical Ward Unit No.01 on 03.02.2015 in a satisfactory and stable condition. His insulin dose was modified as 10 IU in the morning. 15 IU in the afternoon & 20 IU at night time. At present he is admitted in Jail hospital so as to keep a close observation on his health condition.”

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for six months on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The expiry period of six months is to be indicated by the releasing Court.
