Learned State counsel at the outset points out that challan has been presented in this case. He has referred to para 6. Relevant portion of the affidavit which reads as under:-

“That the contents of para 6 of the petition are matter of record. However, it is submitted that since the compromise effected between the parties did not materialized, the complainant appeared before the DIG, Ferozepur Range who directed for conducting an indepth investigation. Since the offences were found to be committed by the petitioner nos. 1 & 2, the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C against them and two others before the Ld. Court of competent jurisdiction. As far as the petitioner no.3 is concerned, he was not found to be present and accordingly he was declared innocent.”

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition.

Same is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
