AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record an extract of her Voting Identity Card(Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 06.08.1992. Petitioner No.2 has placed on record an extract of his Adhaar Card(Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 06.09.1989. Petitioner No.1 has also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Nawanshahar, (Annexure P-4) for protection of her life and liberty and that of her husband i.e. petitioner No.2

Without advertting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior

Superintendent of Police, Nawanshahar, to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.

A copy of this order be given dasti to learned counsel for the petitioners on payment of usual charges.
