Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.04, dated 05.01.2015 under Sections 420, 463, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered against the petitioner at Police Station, Division No.6, Industrial Area, Ludhiana City (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) alongwith consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order dated 19.02.2015, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana on 02.03.2015 to get their statements recorded. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana was further directed to forward a report about the genuiness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the direction passed by this Court, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has sent its report dated 03.03.2015 and has observed

that the parties have arrived at a compromise with their free consent and voluntarily.

Learned State counsel does not dispute about the aforesaid facts.

Considering the report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate that the compromise effected between the parties is genuine, FIR No.04, dated 05.01.2015 under Sections 420, 463, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered against the petitioner at Police Station, Division No.6, Industrial Area, Ludhiana City is hereby quashed.
