Prayer in the petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.241 dated 29.12.2014, under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

In the FIR, it is alleged that the petitioner has agreed to sell the land to the complainant, whereas he has already sold the land in dispute vide registered sale deed dated 10.8.2005 to someone else. Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has pointed out that there are number of criminal complaints pending against the petitioner before the trial Court for offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Prem Chand does not dispute the fact regarding pending criminal complaints against

the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the allegation against the petitioner is serious, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out. It is, however, made clear that the expression made here-in-above shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and confined only to decide the present anticipatory bail application.

Resultantly, the present criminal miscellaneous petition is dismissed.
