Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.127 dated 8.6.2014 registered under Sections 419/420/120-B read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Baund Kalan, District Bhiwani.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has joined the investigation twice over and has also cooperated with the investigating agency. Nothing more is to be recovered from the petitioner and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

The factual aspect of the above-said statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner could not be denied by the learned counsel for the State and rightly so, it being a matter of record. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Radhey Shyam, Police Station Economic Cell, Bhiwani, submits that nothing more is to be recovered from the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 1.4.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
