The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.02 dated 14.01.2015, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sehna, Distt. Barnala.

The learned counsel for the parties state that during the interregnum period, a compromise has been reached and in pursuance thereof, the parties have agreed to file a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

The learned State counsel submits that in view of the compromise, the State has no objection if the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted bail.

Heard.

In view of the statements made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.02.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
