**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondent to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as she is alleged to have been compelled to leave the house.

Learned counsel have argued that in this connection the petitioner has also moved representation (Annexure P-1) to the respondent Nos.2 & 3 and at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is given to said respondents to look into the matter and decide her representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The SSP concerned is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-1) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
