This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.08 dated 11.02.2013, under Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Schedules Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District S.B.S. Nagar on the basis of compromise.

Complainant-respondent No.2 is present in the Court to state that the matter has been compromised and that he does not want to proceed with the case against the petitioners. His statement to that effect has been recorded separately. He has specifically stated that he has no objection if the proceedings are quashed.

In view of the statement made by the complainant made in the Court today and following the full Bench judgment of this Court in

Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR

(Criminal) 1052, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all other criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
