Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.4 to 6 submits that they have no objection to their marriage and as per their information, the petitioners are living happily.

Learned state counsel on instructions from ASI-Gurpreet Singh submits that petitioners have made a statement before the police stating therein that they do not require any security as there is no threat to their lives and liberty.

Accordingly, present petition is rendered infructuous. However, if the petitioners still have any grievance, they are at liberty to seek appropriate remedy available to them under law.
