The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 263 dated 11.11.2014, registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Punjab) under Sections 307, 406, 498-A, 341, 323, 34 IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is Nandoi (brother-in-law) of the complainant. The allegations against the petitioner are that he alongwith other accused encircled the complainant while husband of the complainant poured oil on her. He further contends that mother-in-law and brother-in-law have already been arrested.

The challan has been filed and the case is stated to be fixed for framing of charge on 01.05.2015. The petitioner is in custody for the last five months. The husband is still absconding.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial is taking time, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
