This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. by Onkar Singh, seeking direction to the official respondent to conduct fair and proper enquiry in accordance with law against respondent No.6 who is none else but father-in-law of the petitioner.

A perusal of the file transpires that earlier also the petitioner has filed a petition in which he has detailed the similar facts but that petition was withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars but to the utter surprise instant petition is nothing more than that. The representation is the same which was earlier annexed with the petition. This petition is legally not maintainable and as such, the same is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh representation, if he so desires, to respondent No.2 (The Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala) or respondent No.5 (SSP, Kapurthala) within 15 days which shall be enquired into, dealt with and disposed of by the concerned authorities within a period of three months. In case any substance is found in the allegations to take further appropriate action.
