AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 2 dated 05.01.2015, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel states that he would not press this petition on merits but states that the petitioner has moved a representation (Annexure P-15) to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar wherein she has alleged that the whole case against the petitioner was trumped up and prays that a direction be issued to the Commissioner of Police to look into the said representation and pass an order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances even while dismissing this petition it is

directed that Commissioner of Police, Amritsar would look into the representation(Annexure P-15) of the petitioner and take whatever action he deems necessary on the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
