This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 132 dated 06.09.2010, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Petitioner No.1 Amit Nanda and respondent No.2-Neha are present who state that the matter has been settled and they are living together as husband and wife peacefully, since February, 2015.

In compliance to the order dated 21.02.2015 of this Court, report is received from the trial Court, where statements of the parties were recorded.

It has been stated by counsel for the parties that the parties have compromised the matter. The dispute between the parties was of

personal nature. In view of this, there should not be any impediment in allowing the parties to compromise the matter. Support to this view can be had from the authority **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab, 2008 (2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, wherein Hon'ble the Supreme Court has ruled that in such type of cases where the dispute is of personal nature, Court should ordinarily accept the compromise.

In view of the above, the petition is accepted. The above-said FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.
