Prayer made in the petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.74 dated 10.05.2014 registered under Sections 376, 506 IPC at P.S. Rahon, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that during the course of investigation the petitioners were found innocent and their names were placed in column No.2. It is only on account of summoning under Section 319 Cr.P.C they have been ordered to face the trial.

Learned counsel further states that main accused Malkit Ram has already been granted benefit of anticipatory bail vide order dated 14.07.2014.

In pursuance of order dated 20.02.2015, petitioners have joined the investigation and they have already appeared before the trial Court and the trial Court has already granted them the interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds /surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned D.A.G., Punjab on instructions from ASI Inderjit Singh who is present in Court has not refuted the above-said fact.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.02.2015 is made absolute.

Petitions stands disposed of.
