Vide order dated 20.02.2015, this Court has granted interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.119, dated 10.12.2014, under Sections 452, 336, 148, 149, IPC and 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head-Constable, Jaspal Singh, states that pursuant to the order dated 20.02.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

Accordingly, order dated 20.02.2015 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of.
