Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 01, dated 02.01.2015, under Sections 498-A, 354-D, 509 and 292 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 65 of the Information and Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Women Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 02.07.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from SI Dharamveer, Women Cell, Sonapat, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 02.07.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
