By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115, dated 16.11.2014, registered under Sections 324, 323, 326 r/w Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Khuhian Sarvar, District Fazilka.

The learned counsel contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple and on the non vital part. The petitioner was also medico-legally examined, wherein, two injuries have been noticed on his person. In pursuance of the order dated 06.01.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
