Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No. 97, dated 20.07.2013, for offence under Sections 451, 447, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar (Annexure P-7) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Gurnam Singh PPS, Deputy Supdt. of Police, Sub Division, Rajasansi, Distt. Amritsar (Rural) on behalf of State of Punjab-respondent No.1, the same is taken on record.

In reply, the preliminary submissions reads as under:-

*“That case FIR No. 97, dated 20.07.2013, u/s
451, 447, 34 IPC P.S. Lopoke, Distt. Amritsar (Rural) was*

registered on the written complaint of respondent No. 2 against the petitioners. During investigation matter was investigated/enquired by the answering respondent and the alleged occurrence was not found committed. Hence cancellation report has been prepared on 15.05.2015 which is being presented in the Court as early as possible. Hence petition deserves to be dismissed.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI- Sulkhan Singh, further submits that in the case in hand, the police has prepared a cancellation report on 15.05.2015 and the same would be presented before the trial Court very soon.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present case. Consequently, the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
